Our learning this term will be mainly about: Arctic



We will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction texts linked to our project and we will be using this as a starting point for our

writing. To begin our topic, we will be learning a story about a baby polar bear who asks lots of questions and a story called 'Poles Apart'.

We will also be:

- Making fact cards about the animals that live in the Arctic.
- Label a polar bear.
- Make a polar bear mask.
- Locate the Arctic on a world map.
- Make a polar bear out of clay.
- In P.E. we will be doing 'Arctic Yoga'. So we can explore what it would be like there and what we might see.

In the final 2 weeks of term we will be doing lots of Christmas craft activities.

Just a reminder, that WOW moments are a chance for you to celebrate your child's learning with us. We can then add these WOW moments to your child's learning.




Phonics Workshop
