In Reception we aim to teach so that children have a deep understanding of numbers up to 10. We will be learning to:

Count beyond 10

Adding two single digit numbers

Finding the difference

Comparing numbers


Understand the 'one more/ one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers

Explore the composition of numbers to 10

Automatically recall number bonds of 5 and begin to learn number bonds of 10

Continue, copy and create repeating patterns

Compare length, weight and capacity
