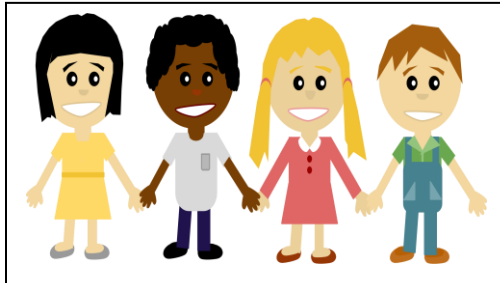


Literacy

Understanding the World-People, Culture and Communities

The children will be learning how to describe their immediate environment, we will begin by locating Langdon Primary School on Google Earth and look closely to see what features are near the school. Next, we will go on a walk to see if we can locate these features.

We will also:

- Draw pictures of their own house and talk about the features in their environment
- Draw a simple map of 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt'

Understanding the World-Past and Present

Each week we will encourage the children to talk about what has happened to themselves at the weekend and draw a picture to show this. We will also be learning about the past in their own lives and create a timeline of their life so far. We will talk about the future and ask the question 'What do you want to be when you grow up?'

Expressive Arts and Design

This term, we will be focusing on painting a self-portrait. We will explore colour mixing to create our own skin colour. Next, we will add detail looking closely to choose the correct colours for our eyes and hair. We will then explore how we are similar and different. Finally, we will create abstract faces by cutting up our self-portraits and mixing them up with another self-portrait.
