
Literacy

Understanding the World-

People, Culture and Communities

We will explore paper world maps and atlases and locate where in the world there are snowy environments.

We will create a simple map of a woodland. Thinking about what we would include: what animals? a path, a house, a river?

Expressive Arts and Design

We will use a range of white and shiny materials to create wintry, snowy pictures.

We will use a variety of different construction materials for children to construct a large model house.



Talk about the different sounds that we can hear in the winter, such as crunching snow, the wind or water dripping as snow melts. Explore a selection of musical instruments and actions to create different sounds to create a wintery soundscape.

We will make a percussion instrument using a variety of resources.



Understanding the world-The Natural World

We will be going on walks to explore and make observations of the natural world to understand important processes and changes in the seasons.

We will explore the changes that happen with water as it is frozen and then warmed, to understand some important processes and changing states of matter.
