Literacy

Our class will be learning and retelling the story 'Rumplestiltskin.'

We will read and learn the story using actions and a story map to help us.

We will be looking at the setting and the characters. The children will we have a go at changing and writing their own fairy tale.

We will also be working on recount writing and instructions this term. We will be learning about the key features of non-fiction texts.

The children will write a recount of our trip to Dover castle and instructions for how to catch a troll

History

In history, we will be learning about castles. We will draw and label the different parts of a castle and look at the purpose of each parts. We will learn about the people who live is castles and learn about the royal family.



Science

This term in science we will be learning about living things and their habitats.

We will be learning to:

- •To identify things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.
- •To compare the differences between things that are living, dead, and things that have never been alive.
- To identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited.
- To identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including microhabitats.
- · Create simple food chains.
- To describe how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals.

Term 4 Castles and Fairy Tales

Art/Design and Technology

This term, we will be using the skills of cutting, bending and joining, that we learned last term, to make individual castle models.

Geography

This term in geography we will be looking at maps of real and imaginary places. We will make 'fairyland' maps using compass directions and a simple key.
