
Literacy

This term we will be linking our literacy to the story, 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch.'

We will read and learn the story using actions and a story map to help us. The children will then change the story to make their own version.

We will also be reading reports about Grace Darling and using these as a starting point to write non-chronological reports.



<u>History</u>

In history, we will be learning about Grace Darling. We will write reports and create a timeline of her life. We will also look at seaside holidays in the past and compare to holidays today.



Science

This term in science we will be learning about plants. We will be learning to:

- Identify and name common wild and garden plants including deciduous and evergreen trees
- Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees
- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.

We will also look at plants that grow under the sea.

Term 6 Lighthouses and the Sea

Art/Design and Technology

This term, we will be drawing and painting lighthouses. We will work in pairs and groups to make model lighthouses.

We will also create colour wash sea creatures and experiment with different materials to make collages of under the sea scenes.

Geography
