
London Class

Our learning this term will be mainly about: LONDON

<u>Literacy—Writing:</u>

Over the next term in our writing we will be concentrating on:

- Reading and discussing stories. Our Talk 4 Writing text will be 'Supertato.' We will read, learn and map the story and the children will then create their own versions.
- Sequencing. We will be sequencing the things that we have done in the holidays and writing simple recounts.
- Writing stories. We will be looking at 'Supertato.' We will use actions and pictures to help us learn the text before we write and change the story.



English—Reading:

In daily Sounds-Write sessions some children will be:

- Learning to segment and blend sounds in 3, 4 and 5 sound words.
- Learning to read and spell multi-syllable words
- Some children will be working within the Extended Code. This is the part of Sounds Write which addresses the more complex spellings of different sounds.

SPELLINGS

Over the next couple of weeks, your child will bring home spellings each Friday. They will be in a yellow spelling book so please check their bookbags and work on these over the week.

We will 'test' them on the following Friday. This is done in an informal way during a normal Sounds Write session.

Mathematics

This term, in mathematics sessions we will be concentrating on place value and will be revisiting the four different calculations.

We will also be learning:

- To read and write 2 and 3 digit numbers
- To count and order numbers
- To add and subtract
- About 2D and 3D shapes



<u> Integrated Learning:</u>

This term we will be learning all about London. Our focus will be geography but our learning will include lots of different subjects. Here are some of the things that we will be learning and doing:

- Making maps of East Langdon and London
- Comparing East Langdon and London
- Look at famous landmarks in London
- Making models of landmarks
- Painting self portraits
- Learning our addresses and posting a letter

In RE, we will be learning about what rules are and looking carefully at our school rules.

In science this term children will learn:

- To distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made
- To identify and name a variety of everyday materials
- To describe the physical properties of everyday materials
- To compare and group together a variety of everyday materials
