# Class Newsletter

## **Literacy**

Our class will be learning the portal story 'Elf Road'.

We will be looking at the important features of a portal story and learning how to use:

- expanded noun phrases
- powerful adjectives and adverbs
- sentence of 3 for description
- 'showing not telling' technique
- suspense

We will create a shared portal story to build confidence with writing them.

The children will then be writing their own portal story.

#### **Maths**

In Maths, we will be focusing on measurement. We will be learning:

- To estimate and measure length
- To measure length in millimetres, centimetres and metres
- To find equivalent lengths
- To use kilometres
- To add and subtract lengths
- To measure perimeter
- To find the area of shapes
- To compare areas

At the end of year 4, children should know all times tables up to 12 x 12 and they will be tested on this knowledge.

#### **Science**

This term in Science, we will be learning about states of matter. We will be learning:

- To compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- To observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius.
- To identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature.
