



## Literacy

Our class will be learning the warning story 'The Lake'.

We will be looking at the important features of a warning story and learning how to use:

- expanded noun phrases
- fronted adverbials
- inverted commas for direct speech
- suspense (show not tell)
- setting description

We will create a shared warning story to build confidence with writing them.

The children will then be writing their own warning story.

## Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on fractions. We will be learning:

- To recognise tenths and hundredths
- To use tenths and hundredths as decimals
- To compare and order decimals
- To round decimals
- To use pounds and pence
- To convert pounds and pence
- To order and estimate money
- To add and subtract money
- To give change

**At the end of year 4, children should know all times tables up to 12 x 12 and they will be tested on this knowledge.**

## Science

This term, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be learning:

- To sort foods into food groups.
- To explore the nutritional values of different foods by gathering information from food labels.
- To sort animal skeletons into groups, discussing patterns and similarities and differences.
- To investigate an idea about how the human skeleton supports movement.
- To explain how bones and muscles work together to create movement.
- To design and carry out my own investigation.
