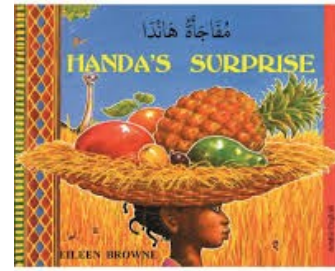


Term 6 June 2024

Welcome back, this week we have been celebrating 'Diversity' and the children enjoyed exploring different cultures, the diversity of abilities and disabilities and celebrating themselves. This term our topic will be all about the story 'Handa's Surprise'. Handa is part of the Luo tribe in South-West Kenya. One day, she decides to fill a basket with seven delicious fruits to bring to Akeyo, who lives in the neighbouring village. As she is walking to see Akeyo, she is so busy thinking which fruit Akeyo will like best, she doesn't even realise some animals are stealing her fruit! She's in for a bit of a surprise when she gets to the village!



Literacy

This term we will be working on a story called 'Handa's Surprise' using actions and a story map to help us. The children will learn the story, then invent a story of their own using the same story structure. Year 1 children, will write a 5 sentence story or more if they can.

We will also:

Find out about the fruits Handa gathered for her friend.

Find out about the animals that appear in the story. Where do they live? What do they like to eat?

Collect some fruit and vegetables into a basket and draw it.

Draw a map showing Handa's route to see Akeyo

Science

Animals Including Humans (Animal Focus)

- Identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals
- Describe and compare the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals including pets)
- Identify and classify common animals



Mathematics

In Reception we aim to teach so that children have a deep understanding of numbers up to 20. We will be learning to:

Count objects, actions and sounds to 20

Count to 20 and beyond

Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal value number

Understand the 'one more, one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers

Explore the composition of numbers to 10

Count in 2's

Know double facts

In Year 1 we will continue our journey with numbers up to 20 and beyond. We will also be learning to:

Read and write 2 and 3 digit numbers

Multiply and divide

Count in 2's 5's and 10's
