



Literacy

Our class will be learning the suspense story 'The Manor House'.

We will be looking at the important features of a suspense story and learning how to use:

- alliteration
- verbs for the character and setting
- fronted adverbials
- expanded noun phrases
- suspense (show not tell)

We will create a shared suspense story to build confidence with writing them.

The children will then be writing their own suspense story.

Maths

In Maths, we will be focusing on fractions. We will be learning:

- To use months and years
- To use hours, seconds and minutes
- To tell the time
- To use a.m. and p.m.
- To use a 24-hour clock
- To convert analogue to digital
- To find turns and angles
- To compare angles
- To recognise and describe 2-D and 3-D shapes

At the end of year 4, children should know all times tables up to 12 x 12 and they will be tested on this knowledge.

Science

This term, we will be learning about animals including humans. We will be learning:

- To identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.
- To know how to keep teeth healthy.
- To identify and describes the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans.
- To construct and interpret a variety of food chains, identifying producers, predators and prey.
