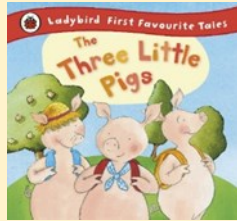

English/ Literacy

This term we will be working on a story called 'The Three Little Pigs' using actions and a story map to help us. The children will learn the story, then invent a story of their own using the same story structure. Year 1 children, will write a 5 sentence story or more if they can.

Mathematics

In Reception we aim to teach so that children have a deep understanding of numbers up to 10. We will be learning to:

Count objects, actions and sounds to 10
Count to 20 and beyond

Link the number symbol (numeral) with its cardinal value number

Understand the 'one more, one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers

Explore the composition of numbers to 10

Learn about properties of 2D shapes

In Year 1 we will continue our journey with numbers up to 10 and beyond. We will also be learning to:

Read and write 2 and 3 digit numbers
Automatically recall number bonds of 10

Count in 2s, 5s and 10s

Add and subtract a single digit number to a two digit number



Science-Materials

In science this term children will learn:

Seasonal Changes

- To observe changes across the 4 seasons.
- To observe and describe weather associated with the seasons and how day length varies.
- ◆ To perform simple tests.



Goldilocks wants to say sorry to Baby Bear and wants to make him a new chair. We will be investigating which materials are best to make a chair that is strong and comfortable.

Year 1 children will also be learning to:

- ◆ To identify and name a variety of common animals.
- ◆ To identify and name animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- ◆ To describe and compare the structure of different animals.
- ◆ To identify, name, draw and label the parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.
