This term the P.E. focus will be dance, taught by Mrs Read.

English/ Literacy



This term we will be working on a story called ' At the End of the Rainbow' using actions and a story map to help us. The children will learn the story, then invent a story of their own using the same story structure. We will be discussing how to use adjectives, adverbs, time connectives and similes to improve our story telling.



Don't forget to log your child's reading on Boom Reader.

Forest School -Our first session will be on Wednesday 25th April. The children can wear their forest school clothes to school on this day. No school uniform please. As it is getting hotter, please remember long sleeves and trousers will still need to be worn.

Art and Design

We will:

- ◆ Make 3D models of a Kenyan animal and paint them.
- ◆ Make a simple collage of the England and Kenyan flags.

Mathematics

In Reception we aim to teach so that children have a deep understanding of numbers up to 10. We will be learning to:

Count objects, actions and sounds to 10

Verbally count to 20 and beyond

Understand the 'one more, one less than' relationship between consecutive numbers

Explore the composition of numbers to 10 and beyond

Automatically recall number bonds up to 5 (including subtraction facts) and some number bonds to 10, including double facts

Learn about properties of 3D shapes

In Year 1 we will continue our journey with numbers up to 10 and beyond. We will also be learning to:

Read and write 2 and 3 digit numbers

Automatically recall number bonds of 10

Count in 2s, 5s and 10s

Add and subtract a single digit number to a two digit number
